#### Feeding Lunches to Youth



FLY will be run differently this year. We have added sites and are up to 13 sites for this summer. Social distancing, masks and gloves will all be part of the required practices when volunteering this summer. Lunches will be made three days a week to cover all 5 days. Partner churches like LCR will

staff an entire week to limit exposure. LCR will be taking the 2nd full week of FLY which is June 15th – 19th. We will be using SignUp.com to coordinate volunteers. The Churches of Marion Food Pantry is open with modified procedures to reduce health risks. They are also now offering no-contact delivery to vulnerable clients, thanks to the help of LCR volunteers. 
### **NEW - Connect Thursdays**

\* PayPal button on the giving page of our website. A PayPal account is not required to complete this gift option.

This fund has three 'buckets' maintenance (building upkeep and repair); ministry (Director of Connections); and Mission (Camp Chisomo, Camp EWALU, Habitat for Humanity, Take Away Hunger event).

Total given to Camp Chisomo for the year is \$2,502, for Habitat for Humanity \$3,880, and for Camp EWALU \$3,000 commitment. Our building maintenance costs for the year through April was \$10,478 and Connections staff & training was \$8,705.
