### **Fellowship Hall Usage Criteria during Covid Restrictions**

*Effective 4-01- 2021*

Limit of 50 people in the reserved area at one time. Reserved area includes fellowship hall, kitchen, and fellowship hall bathrooms. Overflow may utilize the patio and patio parking area plus the grassy area behind the fellowship area. Observe and maintain social distancing in all areas.

Attendees should make sure all members of their party are healthy under the standard guidelines for Covid 19 prevention. The responsible party for this event (the one signing the agreement) shall notify all guests that anyone who is feeling sick, has been exposed to Covid 19 in the last 14 days, or who has tested positive for the Covid 19 virus in the past 14 days must refrain from attending.

Encourage one-way traffic flow through the fellowship area. Enter through the doors by the restrooms and exit by the patio or kitchen door.

Have guests sign in or keep an accurate record of attendees. This could be used for a contact tracing record if necessary

Masks are required for all attendees with the exception of infants. Masks must be worn at all times with the exception of eating and drinking.

Groups at each table should be limited to 8 people and preferably one family.

Food and drink should be served on disposable plates and cups. Disposable utensils should also be used. Avoid reusing serving utensils.

These instructions are subject to change depending on future covid restriction changes.
