# Pastor Nate Montover

After 2.5 years of serving at LCR as a part time Interim Pastor, on March 1 I'll begin to serve among you as your full time Associate Pastor.

The role of the Associate Pastor, as I see it, is to work together with the Senior Pastor to implement a common vision for the public ministry of our congregation.
