I haven't either. In fact, I stopped making resolutions years ago when I discovered how rare it was for me to keep my resolve for more than a week or two. However, I do have new INTENTIONS this year. This year I intend to be more intentional about asking better questions and searching for better answers. In short, this year I intend to reawaken my love for study and specifically the interplay between theology and culture; religious beliefs and ethics; faith and love.

I would love to invite you to join me on this journey as we begin our seminars on Lutheran Theology and the History of the Church at Lutheran Church of the Resurrection. Beginning January 8th we will gather for four Sundays in January and dive deep into one of Luther's most important treatises, "Two Kinds of Righteousness."

In our four week conversations we will think critically about Luther's perspective on faith, love, and the power God gives to humans to carry out God's work of love in the world. We will seek answers to basic questions like, "what is love?" and "what are the limits of human love?" We will also dig deep into Luther's understanding of faith and think critically about the concept of sin.

I would love for you to join us as we meet on January 8, 15, 22, and 29 at noon in the sanctuary. The content of these sessions will mirror the classes I taught at Augustana College and Wartburg Theological Seminary. We will explore the same questions and read the same texts as you would expect in a religion course - without the homework! Look forward to other offerings throughout the year.


#### Lutheran World Federation - Work in Ukraine

The Lutheran World Federation has committed more than \$12.1 million to respond to the crisis in Ukraine. Included in this effort is ongoing work to prevent sexual exploitation and abuse in Ukraine and for Ukrainian refugees. LWF also provides specialized services for people who need treatment for cancer, cardiovascular issues, diabetes, and more by staffing mobile clinics and assisting current efforts including help for those suffering from mental health issues caused by PTSD and trauma. In addition, LWF is supporting hospitals in Ukraine with supplies, including surgical and wound care kits, gauze, IV kits, oxygen masks, defibrillators, stretchers, and medicines, like insulin, morphine, and medications for treating chronic illnesses.

# Stephen Ministry

## Happy New Year!

Our Stephen trainees are busy learning how to care for you. In the month of January they are learning:

#### Maintaining Boundaries in Caregiving

They learn the signs indicating problems with maintaining appropriate boundaries and the consequences of boundary infringements. They briefly explore the difference between servanthood (good) and servitude (bad).

#### Crisis Theory and Practice: Danger versus Opportunity

Stephen trainees identify what needs people in crisis have, learn appropriate ways to care for those needs, and practice those skills.

#### Confidentiality

Stephen Ministers take confidentiality with the utmost seriousness. Trainees learn how to apply simple rules that cover most of the situations they will run into in the caring relationship, in supervision, with well-meaning friends, family, and elsewhere.

#### Telecare: The Next Best Thing to Being There

Caregiving by phone is not as good as caregiving in person, but it's not bad, either, provided you have learned some basic differences in techniques. In this lesson our trainees practice ways to compensate for the shortcomings of caregiving by phone. Note: this lesson was used in the past two years to give care during the pandemic.



The Council met on Tuesday, December 20, 2022. November Secretary's and Treasurer's reports were approved.

**Treasurer:** 100.8% of pledged giving received in November; down from October, but overall about \$88,000 ahead of budgeted amount. Will catch up with tithing at the end of December.

**Pastor Jeff:** 15 family units joined in December. Five services are scheduled for Christmas Eve and one for Christmas Day. Adult Education trip to Holy Land will be February 1st to 21st.

**Pastor Nate:** Have built a relationship with Mt. Zion Church and recently came together for worship. Figuring out how to better utilize our sound equipment.

**Outreach:** Will continue with BINGO in January. Working on a plan for raised beds in the spring. Staff Appreciation Breakfast provided in December.

Governance: no meeting

**Property:** Electronic sign has been ordered, but no install date yet. Getting quotes for carpet.

Stewardship: Working on budget for 2023.

**Old Business:** *Audit Team Update* - working on figuring out how to best report financials. Will have council members serve as check-signers going forward. *Nominating Team* - Bob is working with team to secure council members for the next term.

**New Business:** *Salary Discussion* - Pastor Jeff proposed some salary increases; approved by the council. *2023 budget* - Approved as presented in addition to salary increases.


