

May will be a full month of joy and celebrations here at LCR. We'll have a council sponsored pancake breakfast on the first Sunday of May; Mother's day celebration on the second Sunday of May; Confirmation on the third Sunday in May; and Pentecost Sunday (commemorating the Holy Spirit being poured out on the early church) on the fourth Sunday of May.

All of these different celebrations and especially Confirmation have gotten me to reflect on what it means to be a disciple of Jesus. How are we to live out our faith in the world? Do pancakes and family celebrations relate to discipleship? I think the answer is yes! As our faith calls us to approach all that we do with joy and appreciation. I understand that there are times when life is difficult and it is hard to muster up even an ounce of gratitude; nevertheless we are given this incredible opportunity to live and love in response to what God has first given us.

I can still see the faces of hundreds of Confirmands who have been asked during the Rite of Confirmation: "Do you intend to continue in the covenant God made with you in Holy Baptism: to live among God's faithful people, to hear his Word and share in his supper, to proclaim the good news of God in Christ through word and deed, to serve all people, following the example of our Lord Jesus, and to strive for justice and peace in all the earth?"

I have often told confirmands to think very carefully about what they are about to answer. In other words, are you willing to let the light of Christ guide all that



you do and how you live your life each and every day. This is a powerful affirmation to make and one that reminds us that every day is holy. That every moment is sacred as we are encouraged not to separate our faith from the rest of life; but incorporate it into the very core of who we are.

So here's to discipleship! Here's to confirmation Sunday. Here's to pancakes and family celebrations. Here's to little league games and dance recitals. Here's to chats with good friends and common tasks. And here's to all the ways we are called to live out the faith each and every day. Never forget, each and every moment is sacred.

#### The DAY of PENTECOST - Sunday, May 28th - Wear Red!

There are three great festivals (days of celebration) in the Christian faith: Easter, Christmas, and Pentecost. Pentecost, from the Greek *pentekostos*, meaning fifty, is celebrated fifty days after Easter. Our Jewish friends call this day Shavuot, a festival commemorating when God gave them the Torah. It was on the day of Pentecost/Shavuot that followers of Jesus were gathered together and the Holy Spirit descended upon them like 'tongues of fire.' (Acts 2:2-11)

The miracle of Pentecost was that everyone could hear the Good News being proclaimed in their own language; but the impact of this was a church that found its voice and has been proclaiming the love of God through Jesus Christ ever since. As we gather on Pentecost Sunday may we remember that our voice is still important today - proclaiming God's love and reconciliation through the cross of Jesus. Red is the color of the Holy Spirit and we invite you to wear as much red as you can on Pentecost Sunday!



#### A Sign from God!

Our new sign out front is seen by over 8,200 cars on average per day. This means that the message of God's love at work here at LCR is being shared 24/7 with everything from worship times, to fellowship groups, to special programs. You might even see the picture of someone you know!

**Property:** Contacting REC requiring continued increase in electricity usage. Planning crack repair and carpet replacement. Planning for parking lot asphalt repair. Garage door replacement and minor exterior storm damage repair to come.

Old Business: Sign Fund Appeal - \$3,000 with an additional \$5,000 pledged. New Copier Contract - Have received \$6,000 check from Koch Office Group. Have not heard from Konica Minolta regarding getting out of current contract. Synod Assembly Delegates - Pastors Jeff & Nate will attend.

New Business: Garden Update - Good turnout for raised bed assembly on 4/15. Next step is mulch, wood chips, fencing. Looking for people to take responsibility for a bed. Finance Update - Motion that the Stewardship Team be authorized, in consultation with the treasurer, to ensure that LCR funds are covered under FDIC/NCUA insurance, which would necessitate the moving of up to \$250,000 to the best and appropriate CD's. Motion carried.
