# Stephen Ministry

#### The Ministry of Listening

Think of a time when you really felt cared for. Chances are someone focused on what you had to say, was attentive to your needs, and listened to how you felt instead of telling you how you should feel or what you should do.

Listening is one of the powerful ministry tools. It demonstrates that you care about the other person. In Stephen Ministry, a great deal of time is spent in teaching and practicing listening skills because of its importance in caregiving.

Listening is active. It takes energy and commitment to listen really well. Focus your attention on what the other person has to say instead of thinking of what you'll say next. Make eye contact and nod so that the person knows that you are tuned in.

Listening takes patience. Often you need to build trust before someone will open up to you. Constant, patient listening is key.

Listening involves more than just words. Pay attention to body language. Does it match what is being said?

Good listeners aren't completely silent. They re-state key thoughts or ideas to be sure they understand correctly. They ask focused questions to encourage the person to reach a little deeper.

Listening happens over time. One conversation might build upon an earlier one

Listening is confidential. A great way to build trust and to show the person you really care for him or her is to maintain confidentiality and not share with others what was told to you in private.

We all want the Lutheran Church of the Resurrection to be a caring place where members and guests truly feel people care about who they are and how they feel. Just as Stephen Ministers use good listening skills to communicate how much they care, so can you. Listening is a great gift we can give to one another, and we can use it to make the Lutheran Church of the Resurrection a more caring place.

Our Stephen Ministers are listening and giving care to members of our congregation. We do have Ministers in need of a care receiver, they are ready to listen. Call the church office to receive care.

*Property:* The extra carpeting left over from the gathering space allowed for hallway carpeting to be installed at the price of labor only.


