

One of the greatest honors I have as one of your pastors is participating in the Confirmation program. Confirmation is an opportunity for young members of our congregation, typically 8th graders, to affirm the promises that were made for them at their baptisms.

Who's promises are they affirming? They are affirming the promises of God in Christ to be present with them as they begin their faith journey as adult members of the church.

In Luther's Small Catechism - one of the texts our Confirmation students study - Luther suggests that in Baptism we are not making promises to God, God makes promises to us! It is more than a ritual cleansing with water. Indeed, it is...

Certainly not just water, but the word of God in and with the water does these things, along with the faith which trusts this word of God in the water. For without God's word the water is plain water and no Baptism. But with the word of God it is a Baptism, that is, a life-giving water, rich in grace, and a washing of the new birth in the Holy Spirit, as St. Paul says in Titus, chapter three: "He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom He poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that, having been justified by His grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life. This is a trustworthy saying." (Titus 3:5–8)

In Holy Baptism we affirm that God is at work in our lives beyond our doubts, fears, and desires. Baptism is not our work, it is God's gift and we celebrate with our Confirmation students that God's gifts are active in their lives.


Pancake Party!
