### Brief Order of Confession

Pastor: My friends, hear the good news: “But when the goodness and loving-kindness of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of any works of righteousness that we had done, but according to his mercy, through the water of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit.” (Titus 3.5-6)  
In the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit, your sins are forgiven.
